GSI now accepts the Step Up For Students scholarship toward club dues. Families can use eligible funds to help offset tuition costs. Learn more about STEP UP and eligibility on their official website.

All fees collected by GSI are non-refundable, except in cases where the season is prematurely terminated due to force majeure circumstances.

To streamline the payment process and clearly outline each athlete's financial obligations upfront, GSI has bundled most anticipated expenses into the annual dues. However, airfare and hotel accommodations for athletes are not included in these fees, while travel and lodging costs for coaching staff are covered.

The postseason program is exclusively included for athletes on the 12 Green and Teal teams, featuring two additional months of training, further tournament participation, and four days of competition at the national level, including all associated entry fees. If any Green or Teal team (ages 12 and older) does not qualify for the USAV Girls Junior National Championships, they will alternatively compete in the AAU Junior National Championships in June.

Families are invited to participate in fundraising initiatives or apply for scholarships provided by the Gershfeld and Shakirov Foundation for Youth Development. Details about the scholarship program, including application procedures, will be announced in August 2026 and will be available on our website.
